

Canterbury highlights:

These are our highlights:

- Canterbury Cathedral
- Beany Museum
- Roman Museum
- St Augustine's Abbey
- Walk along the city Walls starting at the top of Castle Street (behind Castle Row car park)
- Punting. We are lucky to have a non-touristy punting company on Water Lane (5 minutes walk from 8 Castle Street). You can either hire a punt for your private group or share a punt and then either punt into the countryside or through the historic centre. To reach it exit 8 Castle Street then walk to the right. At the end of Castle Street turn left. At the end of the road there is a path directly ahead leading to the river, café and the punting company. https://www.canterburypunting.co.uk/. Keep your ticket and get 10% off at The Olive Grove, Weavers, and The Foundry Brew Company & others.
 - Alternative there is another punting company operating the same river network but starting at Westgate towers at the other end of the high Street
- Canterbury Guided Tours either group, private or themed tours. https://www.canterburyguidedtours.com/
- Canterbury Ghost Tours
- Eastbridge Hospital, where Pilgrims stayed whilst visting the shine of Thomas Becket, restored chapels, sleeping quarters and dining hall
- Greyfriars Chapel set within Greyfriars Garden. Remains of one of the first UK Franciscan Priory

For an evenings entertainment, please consider the following:

- Theatre Marlowe Theatre. The Gulbenkian Theatre (on the University of Kent Campus).
- Cinema Riverside Cinema and Curzon cinemas are both in the centre of town. The Gulbenkian on the University of Kent Campus also has a cinema and shows a mixture of mainstream and art films
- Houdini's Magic Bar
- Lady Luck for live music and vegan food
- Check the Kent Country Cricket Spitfire Ground for their 3 big named bands live outdoor shows
