

What to do or see outside of Canterbury

Visit www.canterbury.co.uk and click on Things to Do for ideas in Canterbury and surrounding villages.

These are our suggestions:

Towns/Villages with character:

- Whitstable, Tankerton lovely walks along the seafront with lots of independent shops, fishing harbour, beach huts, seafood stalls. Walk along "The Street", a street that stretches for a mile out into the sea just off Tankerton (watch out for the tides). From the harbour go on board a historic Thames Barge or get a speedboat out to the WW2 forts or spot Sea Lions on the sand banks (booking is advised)
- Herne Bay sea front and Pier with beach huts, mini golf, amusements
- Chilham walk from Canterbury or take the train, visit the Castle gardens (open days are Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday (closed from September until Spring), visit the haunted church and have a cream tea in the village square
- Wye train from Canterbury. Walk up to the North Downs. Eat/drink at the Tickled Trout beside the River Stour
- Folkestone enjoy the beach, fishing harbour. Go under the arches to the left of the harbour for a series of seafood stalls and pubs which on a Sunday play live music
- Broadstairs park down by the harbour, enjoy the long sandy beaches (watch out for the tides), restaurants and independent shops
- Faversham market town, visit the Shephard Neame Brewery, walk along the Faversham Creek and Oare Creek
- Margate sandy beach, independent shops, Turner Contemporary Art Gallery, shell grotto, caves.

Zoo's:

Castle's:

- Dover Castle entry to the Castle, grounds, tunnels.
- Leeds Castle entry to the Castle, gardens, grounds (including a maze)
- Walmer and Deal Castle

Gardens:

- Chilham Castle opens its gardens up to the public
- Open gardens this is a National Garden Scheme where private owners and country estates
 open up their gardens to the public on specific days of the year. Visit https://ngs.org.uk/ to find
 a garden in Kent.

Beaches:

- Sandy beaches in Broadstairs, Pegwell Bay, Botany Bay, Margate
- Stony beaches in Whitstable, Tankerton, Herne Bay, Folkestone, Dover, Romney, Hythe, Dymchurch.

Vineyards (wine tours):

Kent has similar growing conditions to those in the Champgne region of France. French brand Tattinger has recently purchased vineyards between Canterbury and Chilham. Other Kent vineyards regularly win awards, supply to Harrods and other leading high-end stores.

- Chartham Vineyard open Saturdays 10.30 to 5 for sales, tours, tastings & art shows
- Barnsole Vineyard (boutique award-winning vineyard, at Staple near Canterbury)
- Simpsons Wine Estate (Barham, near Canterbury)
- Biddenden Vineyard (oldest and award winning wine, the other side of Ashford)
- Chapel Down Vineyard, Tenterden (the other side of Ashford). Award winning, supplies Harrods and other prestigious venues. Offers wine, sparking wines and now gin.
